exclusive benefit of her the \$ Sella and her heirs the sum
of two hundred dollars.

3rd I give to my daughter Elizabeth Hunt and her heirs for
the exclusive benefit of her the \$ Elizabeth and her heirs the
sum of two hundred dollars.

4th The balance of my Estate (after paying my just debts, expenses
of administration &c.) I direct to be equally divided between
my other seven children or between the Survivors and
the heirs of those who may be deceased to Wit: William
Hunt the heirs of Thomas Hunt Dec: Mark Hunt:
the heirs of Jesse Hunt Dec: John Hunt the heirs
Catharine Halley Dec: and William L. Schuertz, the husband
of my daughter Matilda.

Lastly I hereby appoint William B. Cannahan executor
of this my last Will and Testament.

requires Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate
