Draper my negro man, James; and I desire that the remainder of my property shall be equally divided amongst Jane C. Tate, John S. Draper, Margaret S. Draper, and I furthermore desire that the sum of five hundred dollars be paid over to John S. Draper's Committee in lieu of her portion of this property, the said sum to be paid by Jane C. Tate, John S. Draper, Margaret S. Draper, and I also direct that Jane C. Tate shall not be subject to her husband's debts or control, and I desire remains incapable of disposing of her property, after her death I direct her share to be equally divided amongst the other three children or their heirs, subject to the same limitations as the property above disposed of and I do hereby nominate and appoint John S. Draper & Samuel R. Lagers to be executor of this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I this my last will and Testament I have set my hand and seal, the 26th day of November in the year 1858.

Lagers the other probate having in said will as one of the Executors having authority to act as such for the James M. Crockett and Hamilton Lagers as his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five Thousand Dollars, with such cancelling as the law requires, and having qualified according to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of said will in due form.
