I have 2nd I give & bequeath to my wife Elizabeth during her natural life
all that portion of my land is back of land purchased from William Camp-
bell lying on the North Eastern side of the R. R. & Towns West Road and at her
death to my son Robert, and in the event of his death before my wife to
his children to be equally divided between themI have 3rd I give to my son David & William the tract of land purchased
of Robert Sprout, Henry Patton & Henry Thos. the land bought of the
late Thos. being part of Thos. Thos. land, to be divided according to a
