In Obedience to an Order of the County Court of Salem the County directing me to state and settle the the account of Henry James Lyezer Executor of Henry Lyezer decd and report the same to Court. I do leave to submit the foregoing statement and account.

By the 1st Statement will be seen the amt. of funds which fell into the Executors hands on the 5th day of Feb. 1846 in due Bonds, which is after paying all demands against the Estate and allowing the Executors the usual percent Commission \$8,305.62 principal & interest demand in the Executors hands on the 6th day of Jan. 1845. the fund which fell into the Executors hands on the 5th day of Feb. 1846 is \$8,902.30 and \$1982.24 dit. to that date which sum is directed by the will (a copy of which is herewith filed marked 10) to be equally divided between his children 5 in number which makes each distributable share \$1640.46 and \$396.47 dit. thereon, and after allowing all bequests for disbursements there remains in the hands of the Executors the sum of \$8305.62 on the 6th day of Jan. 1845 as before stated.

The 2^d Statement shows the advancements to each heir in the life time of the decd which is directed by the will to be made equal at his death, the total amount of which including the value of two slaves willed to James Lyezer by the will at \$1000.00 is \$5015.00 & \$1849.96 dit. which when equally divided makes each distributable portion 1003.00 and \$369.99 (See receipt of advancements herewith filed marked 12)

The 3rd Statement shows an account of each heir which shows after charging each with their portion of advancements and receipts and dit thereon there is due each on the 6th day of Jan 1845 the following sums including dit. to date
