July a debt for Cass to (paid by me) against Samuel Caffee Sr. also my claim in a tract of land known as the White Plains, also my interest in a sum of money which due in England.

to the time of my Mother Sarah Stephens Dec^r (with a request
of the same shall be collected that they make a generous donation
of the same with brother Hugh Davis Sarah's share on the time
