Friday the 5 day of September 1831, proceeded to appraise,  
allot and divide the Slaves belonging to the Estate of Philip  
Cochran deceased (those belonging to the Dower excepted)  
among those severally entitled thereto, and after first appraising  
the said Slaves we found their value to be \$ 957<sup>33</sup> as may be seen  
by reference to page , showing a dividend of  
\$ 957<sup>33</sup> 100 to each of the distributees of the Estate of said Decedent  
there being 10 in number . We then proceeded to allot and  
No the said Slaves from No 1. to No 10. respectively , and when  
thus allotted and numbered we found the lots to vary a little in  
value according to our first appraisement , as will be seen  
by Reference to page , but when we called each lot by  
name and placed them before us for a Review of the same  
we upon a review of the lots Considered , that there was no  
difference of valuation of said lots , as we had numbered  
and Closely the said Slaves . We then proceeded to distribute  
the several lots of Slaves as appraised among those severally  
entitled thereto by Ballots , when Lot No 10. fell to Elizabeth  
Jordan , Lot No 1. to the Relator of Philip Cochran deceased  
Lot No 3 , to John Cochran , Lot 10<sup>1</sup> to George Cochran

difference of valuation of said lots, as we have numbered  
and Slaves. Neither proceeded to distribute  
the several lots of slaves as aforesaid among those severally  
entitled thereto by ballot, when Lot No 10. fell to Elizabeth  
Jordan, Lot No 4. to the heirs of Philip Eastham deceased  
Lot No 3, to John Eastham, Lot. No 7 to George Eastham  
Lot No 5 to Brod Eastham, Lot. No 6 to Ann a Hand  
Lot No 8 to Braxton Eastham, Lot. No 1 to Robert Eastham  
Lot No 2 to Lawson Eastham, Lot. No 9 to B. P. Eastham  
all of which is now most respectfully submitted to the Honorable  
Court of Rappahannock. Given under our hands this 8th  
day of September 1834.
