This last will and testament of Easter Velinda Adams

Stone and Walter Halland, two of the subscribing witnesses

ued and held for Rappahannock County on Wednesday the 12th day of
March 1839. It being proved to the satisfaction of the Court by the
oath of a witness that Edward Griffin the sole Executor named in
the last will and testament of Easter Velinda Adams deceased,
which has been admitted to record in this Court declared that
he would not take upon himself the burden of the Execution
thereof and no person having applied for letters of administra-
tion on the estate of the said deceased, it is ordered that
