

Pursuant to a order from the County Court of Rappahannock
was directed Mr. Linn this day settled the admin^r account of
Catharine Deatherage admin^r of George Deatherage deceased, a
Statement of which is attached. It will be seen by said Statement
that the debts paid by the admin^r since the death of deceased
amount to the sum of \$441.90 all of which were supported by
sufficient vouchers, and showed that the said sum had been properly
and legally paid to the creditors of deceased. It will also appear
that the Commissioner allowed the admin^r the sum of \$108.00 for
Commission being 5 per cent on the amount of sale and money received.
We think that said sum will not more than pay the administrative
fees & trouble in settling the various accounts due the Estate
there being a number of them due the said deceased, the making
of charges for expenses. We also report, that from the Sale
Book, the sum of \$209.01, the amount of purchase by the admin^r
and the sum of \$781. the amount of Collections of Sale Bonds
include the whole amount of the sale of the perishable property, with
the exception of about \$50. yet uncollected. Given under our hands
