Deatherage, who made oaths according to Law, and with Minn Watson their Security (who justified upon oaths, in open Court as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$8000 conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of the said Landy Waters deceased, with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.
