

I gave to Lewis C. Turner some time past, the sum of one thousand
dollars, I am desirous of placing the sons of my brother Zephaniah Turner
upon an equality so far as regards what I may specially give them.
I therefore give and bequeath to Jacob Turner, Zephaniah Turner
Israel C. Turner and Richard A. Turner sons of my brother Zeph-
aniah Turner the sum of one thousand dollars each, I likewise give
and bequeath to Susan C. Turner, a married woman Turner & Maria
Elizabeth Turner daughters of my brother Zephaniah Turner the sum
of two thousand dollars each. Having as before mentioned
given to Lewis C. Turner, one thousand dollars which was in
cash, I therefore declare, that I have from that circumstance been
induced to make to the other sons of my brother Zephaniah the bequests
contained in this Codicil to my will. I give to my nieces Catharine
and Jane Turn daughters of Benjamin Turn the sum of five
hundred dollars, to be equally divided between them. In Witness
