

Louisa Jeffers do hereby make this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say,
1st I desire that my Estate both real personal and mixed
by my father shall be equally divided between my three sisters
Frances Wood, Sarah Jones and Jeannette Jeffers. I desire
that Jeannette Jeffers shall have my interest in land in
Smith, by Jeannette Jeffers paying in money for the same to
Frances Wood and Sarah Jones so as to make them all equal
in value. Whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this
day of October 1834
