

I, Mary Jordan of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia
do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and
form following, that is to say:

First - I give and bequeath unto my niece Sarah E. Jordan one
negro girl named Caroline, and her future increase, to her, and her
heirs forever. Also her share of one of my Beds, and furniture
to the same. I also desire that she shall have the right, to live in,
and enjoy in peaceable possession my half of the House, in which
Joseph Suttle now lives, so long as she lives single. Also one
Bond of twenty dollars payable by William Jordan Jr, and one
Bond payable by her father William Jordan, the amount of which
I do not now recollect. Also I give and bequeath unto her my side
saddle.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my Sister Sarah B. Culey Twenty
dollars to be paid as soon as can conveniently be done.

Thirdly. I give and bequeath unto my niece Elizabeth Whiting twenty
dollars to be paid as soon as can conveniently be done.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath unto my two Nieces Lucy and Mary
Jordan the daughters of my Brother Absalom Jordan each the sum
of ten dollars to be paid as soon as can conveniently be done.

Fifthly, and lastly. - I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Thomas S.
Suttle, all the remaining part of my estate both real and personal
forever. I also desire, that if any claim or claims or any accounts
to be taken, should hereafter be brought against me or my estate, that
the property which I have bequeathed to my said Nephew Thomas
S. Suttle shall go to the payment of the same. I also further
desire, that if the said Nephew Thomas S. Suttle should die

whatsoever, should hereafter be brought against me or my estate, that
the property which I have bequeathed to my said Nephew Thomas
St. Suttle shall go to satisfy such claims or accounts. I also further
desire, that if he my said nephew Thomas St. Suttle should die
before he arrives to the age of twenty one years, that the property which
I have bequeathed to him, shall be divided into three equal shares
and his Mother Rachael Suttle, to have one share, my Brother
Abraham Jordan's two daughters one share, and my sister Sarah
Cory's single daughters the other share.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends John St. Wood and
Addison Turner my executors of this my last Will and testament,
hereby revoking all other former Wills or testaments by me heretofore
