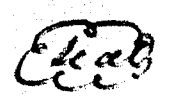

according to Law, and with Mary M. Jacobs his security (who made
oath as to her sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a
bond on the penalty of one hundred dollars conditioned as the Law
directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a license of administration
on the Estate of the said Nancy Beck deceased with
