it hath pleased God to endow me with, in the following manner
to wit;

I give to my sister Cholly Daniel, what ready money I
may have, Linen and yee, hoop poles and Skillets, two Milch
Cows, three sheep, one bed and bed clothing, one bureau and
contents, one cupboard and contents, one chest and contents
and Saddle, chairs, one dining Table, and my interest in
a negro man named London to her and her heirs forever.
I give to my niece Wapandina (Daniel) one bed and
bed clothing, and one white back calf, to her and her
heirs forever.

I give to my dear mother one calf to her and her heirs for-
ever.

Lastly I nominate and constitute on appoint John M. Pierce
my executor of this my last will and Testament hereby appointing
all former and other wills by me made, I declare this to be my
last, and do witness my hand and Seal 3rd day of December 1838.
