in the Estate of Thomas Hale deceased so on this day
returned into Court, examined by the court, and ordered to
be recorded.





In obedience to an order of the (then) Court of Hapahannock, the like undesignated being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, decribed and assigned the land of the Estate of Sarah Mayes deceased, in the following manner, two lots - 1^o & 2^o found containing together 11^{1/4} acres to Anthony, deceased. - 1^o & 2^o containing together 163^{3/4} acres to John D. Manning - 3^o & 4^o containing together 155^{1/4} acres to Stephen Hayes and to Elizabeth Green lots - 1^o, 2^o, & 3^o containing together 158^{1/4} acres. The aforesaid lots are all designated and bounded, as will appear from the map of the surveyor hereunto returned.
