We the Subscribers pursuant to an order from the County Court of
Happahannock, bearing date September 1835, and having
appeared before first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for the
purpose have this day settled and adjusted the administering
Account of Elizabeth Foley on the estate of Thomas Foley deceased
and her proper vouchers placed before us we find that the amount
of appts that come into the hands of the said administratrix
amounts to the sum of Three thousand Eight hundred and
Eighty two dollars and fifty one cents and that the said
said amount to the sum of one thousand seven hundred
and twenty five dollars and fifty one cents, having a balance
in the hands of the said administratrix the sum of one

a Ten Hundred and ninety nine dollars and sixty cents of which balance arises from this Bond, on 11th of June and John Smith not yet collected, and due in the following manner, viz: One Bond for Three hundred and thirty three dollars and twenty cents, due the 26th day of September 1855, one due the 26th day of September 1856, for a like sum, and the other due the 26th day of September 1857 for a like sum. And one Hundred and forty five dollars and forty one cents of the above mentioned Balance arises from a Bond on James B. Bunker and William Duane, due the 26th Sept. 1855 not yet collected. We also report that there was one hundred and ninety three dollars and fifteen cents in cash on hand at the death of the said Decedent from the statements made to us, and that the whole sum was paid out to creditors before the said Administrator obtained letters of administration.

We further report that we find charged on said decedent's Book the sum of Two Hundred and ninety four dollars and fifty cents to Charles Cox, one of the Legates of said Decedent, which did not come into the hands of the said Administrator and that the further sum of Four hundred and thirty seven dollars and thirty five cents stands charged to Landy P. Waters another of the Legates of said Decedent, which likewise did not come into the hands of the said Administrator: which two sums added to the above mentioned balance of one hundred and fifty seven dollars and thirty six cents of assets, making the sum total Twenty six hundred and eighty nine dollars and twenty one cents, all of which we respectfully submit to the respectful Court of Rappahannock Co. VA Will Book A, 1833-1842.
