tioned) after deducting therefrom the above named sum of Ten
hundred and six dollars, also the further sum of five hundred
and ninety dollars, paid to their deceased father heretofore.

4^o To the children of William Tapp (My son) I give, one ~~third~~
part, deducting therefrom the sum of Three hundred and
eighty two dollars, ~~the sum of~~

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6th I give unto Vincent Japp, my son, one sixth part thereof.
 7th I give to the three single daughters of my daughter Betty
 Japp, one sixth part thereof, after deducting therefrom the sum
 of twenty five dollars here to be paid them father and
 8th I give unto the four daughters of my daughter in Law Jane
 Japp, one sixth part thereof, after deducting therefrom the sum
 of one hundred and twenty dollars, the value of a Lot of Land
 heretofore given to their said mother Jacob Japp, in which they
 have an interest.

And Lastly, I make and constitute my friend James
 W. Nelson, my Executor of this my last will and testament.
