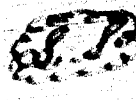

Berkley. In the name of God, Amen, I Elizabeth Berkley of Rappahannock County Virginia, do hereby make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say.
1st I give to Susan B. Berkley my black girl Dolly to have and dispose of as she may think proper.
2nd I give unto Susan B. Berkley, Thomas B. Berkley, Richard B. Berkley, Mary E. Berkley and Ann Catharine Berkley all the remainder of my Rappahannock Vlg. personal and real estate to be equally divided between them.
3rd I appoint my brother Thomas Berkley executor of this my last will and testament And should the legatee either or more

of these my children, or descendants to see and
estate, either real or personal before they should become of age,
twenty one years; that the executor Thomas Berkeley shall have full
power to make a good and warrantable right, not to be recalled
after they become of age. In witness whereof I Elizabeth Berkeley
to this my last will and testament have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 7th day of Feby. 1843
