As my son Henry in his lifetime has received from me in
addition to what I have been obliged to pay for him as his
security, more than what I consider his fair part of my
property after paying my debts - I devise to my daughter

I am at all the real property which I own or may hereafter
own I give and bequeath to my said daughter James Spiller
all my negroes and such as may hereafter be born, my house
hold and kitchen furniture, and all my other property
real and personal of every description, my intention being
that my son Henry's children shall receive no part of my
estate. I hereby constitute and appoint Amos Dear executor
of this my last will and testament and in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the
eleventh day of January in the year one thousand eight hun
dred and forty three.

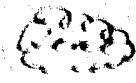
