

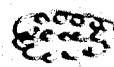
Robert Jones In the name of God, Amen: I Robert Jones of the County of

memory and knowing the uncertainty of human life and being
desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased
God to bless me with I do hereby make my last will and testament
in manner and form following.

1st. After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, I
give to my wife Susanah all of my estate both real and personal
for and during the term of her natural life and after her de-
cease, I desire that all of the estate both real and personal be
immediately sold by my executor hereafter named and the mon-
ey arising from the sale to be equally divided between my chil-
dren namely, my daughter Elizabeth now Elizabeth Brown, my son
Mordica Jones my son William Jones and my son Robert Jones
dece? lawful heirs and my daughter Susanna now Susanna
Thornhill, my daughter Ann now Ann Burke and my son Gabriel
my son Franklin and my daughter Sumnerville now Sumner-
ville Brown to them and their heirs forever and also my daugh-
ter Jane now Jane Vaughan to her and her bodily heirs
and to them, their heirs, executors, administrators & assigns forever.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William
Jones Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revo-
king all other former wills or testaments by me heretofore
made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 8th day of February 1845

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William
Executor of this my last will and testament hereby ~~over~~
revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me heretofore
made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands & affixed
my seal this the 3rd day of February 1845

This last will and testament of Robert Jones dec^d was
this day produced to the Court, proved by the oaths of John N. Miller
and John A. Popham two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered
to be recorded. And on the motion of William Jones the Executor there
in named, who made oath thereto and together with John N. Miller &
John A. Popham his securities (who justified on oath as to their suf
ficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of
\$10000 conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him
for obtaining a probate of said will in due form
