Fisher's & and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking
Will and making void all former wills by me at any time heretofore made. And as to such worldly estates as it hath pleased God to entrust me with, I dispose of the same as follows: First, I direct that all my debts & funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible, out of the first moneys that shall come into the hands of my Executors, from any portion of my estate, real or personal.

Secondly: I give to my wife Lucy A. Fisher one third part of my estate both real & personal (after the payment of all my debts) during the term of her natural life and after her death, I give

among them, and to be enjoyed by them (my children) forever.
The other two thirds of my estate both real & personal I
give to my children (by my said wife) to be equally divided among
them. Also I direct that all the real estate of which I
shall be seized or possessed shall be sold by my executrix if in
her judgment or opinion she may think it best to sell said
real estate, either at public or private sale for current money
on credit or for cash & the amount thereof if sold on credit
to be secured in such manner as is usual in like cases to ensure
the full & punctual payment thereof. And to effectuate this my
intention I do hereby vest in my Executrix full power & authority
to dispose of all my real estate, in fee simple or for a term of
years, or otherwise in as full and large a manner, in every respect
as I could myself do if living. And I do further direct that
if my executrix should think it proper to sell some real estate,
and such sale is effectual, that the amount of money arising
from such sale shall be laid out for other land in the real
or elsewhere, & such land so purchased by my executrix, one
third thereof shall be enjoyed by wife during her life as above
and at her death to be equally divided among my children and
the other two thirds of land so purchased shall be equally divided
among my children. And lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint
my wife Lucy A. Fisher Executrix of this my last will & testament.
