I leave you and bequeath to my grand daughter Ellen the
sum of the sum of my son Little James Two hundred
dollars instead of having my thing to my son Little
and I hereby constitute and appoint Robert M. Steward executor
of the my last will and testament and have hereto
subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 10th day
of 1855 in the year one thousand eight hundred and
fifty five
I give you the negro publisher and
make a note for the two same and
purchase of the said book money
