Will.

Know all men, by these presents; that I, Francis Whitescarver of the County of Rappahannock and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, viz: It is my will and desire that after the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses, the residue of my estate both personal and real shall be equally divided among all my children, as follows and upon the following conditions.

1st If my son George W. Whitescarver shall pay to my executor hereafter to be named, the amount of an execution which I paid for him, then he is to receive his full portion; otherwise it is my will that he receive nothing and the portion allotted to him be equally divided among my other children.

2nd It is my will that one half the amount devised to my daughter Bethany Weaver be paid to her daughter Mary Elizabeth Johnson when she shall have attained to the age of twenty one years, and the remaining half I leave in trust to Mr. M. Weaver (my son in law) to be appropriated in the education of his two sons G. J. and M. L. Weaver.

3rd It is my will that if my son Winston P. Whitescarver shall return to my son Robert A. Whitescarver the money he borrowed of him with interest then shall he receive his full portion, but if he fail to comply with the aforementioned condition, then it is my will that my son Robert A. Whitescarver shall have the amount allotted to W. P. Whitescarver.

4th I give and bequeath to my son Robert A. Whitescarver the

(my son-in-law) to be appropriated in the education of his two sons J. L. and M. L. Weaver.

3rd It is my will that if my son Winston P. Whitescarver shall return to my son Robert A. Whitescarver the money he borrowed of him with interest then shall he receive his full portion, but if he fail to comply with the aforementioned condition, then it is my will that my son Robert A. Whitescarver shall have the amount allotted to W. P. Whitescarver.

4th I give and bequeath to my son Robert A. Whitescarver the trunk left to me by my son Joseph.

5th It is my will that my executor shall sell my house and lot situated in the town of Washington, Rappahannock County, Va. either publicly or privately as he may think best.

6th I hereby appoint Robert A. Whitescarver sole executor of this my last will and testament, thereby revoking all former wills by me made. Witness my hand and seal this 12th day of July one thousand eight hundred and fifty five - 1855.
