

John Pullen of the County of Wappahannock and State of Vir-
ginia being weak of body but of sound mind and disposing mi-
nd and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life do make
this my last will and testament in manner and form following
revoaking all other wills heretofore made by me.

Item 1st. I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be
first paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the proceeds
of the sale of my personal property.

Item 2d I will and bequeath to my wife Nancy Pullen during her
natural life the tract of land upon which I reside at this time
being that portion of the land that I got in the division of the
land between myself and my brother Thomas Pullen. At the death
of my wife Nancy I will and bequeath the aforesaid tract of land
to my son Mark and his children forever except a lot of land
adjoining the land of John Jones formerly the property of Judge
according to the following metes and bounds beginning at a
large chestnut oak near the top of the hill near the
line of said Pullen and Jones & running then South 75. 2 1/2 miles
to a very large Hickory, thence S 40 W 11.56 feet to a large gum
tree then West 70 feet to an old chestnut standing on the
top of mountain on the line of said Pullen and Jones thence
thence 206 feet to a red oak mast, then in the line of
Pullen & Jones forever, then thence with that line S 80 E 25
6 feet to the beginning containing 2. 20. 5 feet more or less
Item 3d I will and bequeath to the said Mark and his children
forever the same.

land of John Gaa and Martin Gaa lying on the east side of
Pop Mountain containing 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.
Item 4th I will and bequeath to the said Merman Pugh and his
children my distilling apparatus, of every description and also
my blacksmith tools forever.
Item 5th My wife and desire is that after my death and the death
of my wife Nancy Pullen, I desire that my servant shall be free
and I bequeath to her twenty acres of land more or less including
the house that William Reed is now living in and I nominate and
appoint Merman Nash to be her guardian and the said Merman
Nash is authorized to make and give to I desire a warrant deed
and full possession of the aforesaid tract of land for her maintenance
and support during her natural life.
Item 6th I give and bequeath unto Joseph Pullen and his heirs
forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of
Rappahannock and adjoining the land of William Brown and
a tract of land known as the Bryant tract, and also a tract of
land belonging to John Gaa. I give known as the Dean tract of land
directing the cultivated land on the south side of Favorite Mountain
and running to the top of said Favorite Mountain and a
straight line 85⁰⁰ 81⁴⁴ poles to three small hickories to have and
to hold to the said Joseph Pullen and his heirs forever.
Item 7. My wife and desire is that Henry L. Menefee be my executor
and nothing else other will, legacies and bequests therefore
made by me and declaring this and no other to be my last
and testament.
