

John Romner of the County of Appomattox and State of Virginia being of sound mind and disposing memory declare this to be my last will and testament.

In the first place I want all my funeral expenses together with all my just debts paid by my executor hereafter named from the sale of such property as my wife thinks she can best spare.

In the next place I give all of my property both real and personal to my wife Maria Romner during her natural life with the privilege of she may see proper to make such advancements to any of my children as she may think convenient for her to do.

Charging such child or children with the amount to be accounted for at her death after which I want all my estate both real and personal equally divided among all my children either by sale in part or all as a majority of them may think best.

The interest or portion of my estate that is coming to my daughter Maria Elizabeth Dawson the wife of John Dawson I leave in trust with my son William Romner, to be paid to her in such sums as he may think will contribute most to her comfort, but to be entirely free from any control of her husband.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William Romner my executor. Given under my hand and seal this 8th day October 1859

Done at a Court held for the said County on Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1864 the last will of John Brown deceased was again produced to the Court. And on the motion of William A. Brown, the Executor thereof named, who made oath thereto and together with Isaac M. Nelson, Richard B. Thornbush, William H. Wright and Thomas Brown his securities (who qualified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$20,000 conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form
