said Elizabeth Sells - and I do Mrs. Gemma Reynolds who assists
with me is to remain with the said E. Sells and receive a support
as long as she lives, out of my estate.

and affix my seal this July in the year one thousand eight
hundred and fifty one (1851.)

In Rappahannock County Court January 9th 1865
This last will of Landon Gilman deceased was this day produced

Hogg her security who justified on oath
