I give and bequeath to my beloved brother James Brown after paying my just debts - all that I possess of worldly goods and all property of all kinds, both real and personal.

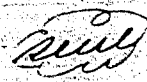

This last will of Margaret Brown deceased was this day produced to the Court and partly verified by the oath of Suey A. Hawkins one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and which is ordered to be certified and at a Court held for the said County on the 11th day of April 1865, this last will was again produced to the Court, fully verified by the oath of John S. Brown another of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
