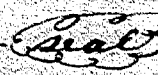

pleased God to bless me with. I give and devise the same in manner
following that is to say 1st I give and devise to James D Nicol my cow and
bed for his special benefit 2nd I give and devise to my daughter Hettie
Nicol and her other two sons William G Nicol and John A. Nicol the residue
of my household and kitchen furniture for their special benefit forever.
and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends W^m W. Brown &
John A Buckner Executors of this my last will and testament hereby re-
