

In the name of God Amen I Mary A. Moore of the County
of Rappahannock and State of Virginia being of good body,
health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, calling
to mind the frailty and uncertainty of human life and being
desirous of settling my worldly affairs and directing how the same
shall be managed after my decease, I have caused this my last will and testament
to be written in the presence of my friends and acquaintances
and I have signed and sealed this my last will and testament
hereby revoking and annulling all other last wills and testaments by
me heretofore made.

And first I commend my immortal soul to him who gave it
and my body ^{the same is to} to be buried by my executor hereinafter named
without unnecessary expense or ostentation.

As to my worldly affairs, and all the property real personal
or mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which
I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, I do hereby bequeath
and dispose of in the manner and form following to wit.

Imprimis My will is that all my just debts and funeral
expenses shall be paid by my executor hereinafter named named to be
paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as by him
shall be found convenient.

Imprimis I give and bequeath to my beloved niece Eliza Jane
Nichols daughter of Elezeiah Nichols decd. the sum of seven
hundred dollars in money to be paid to her or her legal guard-
ian by my executor hereinafter named as early as possible
after my decease, to have and to hold the same to her her heirs
and assigns forever.

Imprimis I also devise and bequeath to my said niece Eliza Jane Nickells, one bedstead bed and bedding, one bureau, one wardrobe and all other articles of household and kitchen furniture of which I may be seized and possessed at the time of my death.

Imprimis All the rest and residue of my estate real personal and mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to bequeath to my sister Elizabeth Ann Nickells, wife of George Heath Nickells decd. for her sole separate use and benefit during the term of her natural life, to have hold and enjoy the rents and profits of the same, and at her death it is my wish and desire that the same be equally divided amongst my niece Eliza Jane Nickells, Martha Nickells, Rebecca Nickells, Nancy Nickells, Emma Nickells and Lucinda Nickells daughters of my sister the said Elizabeth Ann Nickells wife of Heath Nickells deceased.

Saidly I do nominate and appoint John Elias Nickells to be the Executor of this my last will and Testament.

Witness my hand and publish as the last will and Testament of the said Mary Ann Moore, at her request and in her presence, and in the presence of each other have subscribed as witnesses hereto this 22d day of November 1861
