

I know & give & make my last will & testament in manner and form as follows
1st I give and devise to my niece Eliza Ann the all that part of my late plantation in
County of Rappahannock lying land of Mills Run Branch and of a line running from
mouth of the said Branch to Mrs Andersons gate also the wood land west of the said Branch
by my late said Branch and the fence nearest said Branch including the fence by Mills
Run Branch I mean the Branch on which there was an old Stiles House
2nd I give and devise to my Niece Fanny Anderson and my Nephews Peyton Anderson
Henry Anderson and William Anderson the residue of my lands in Rappahannock County
3rd I wish my Executors to have a Tombstone placed over the grave of my Nephew Joseph
Anderson and authorize them to expend for that purpose not less than One Hundred nor
more than Five Hundred dollars
4th I give to my Nephew Alfred Jones Atkins One Thousand Dollars
5th It is my will that all my personal property be sold and out of the proceeds thereof and
and of the collection of debts owing me I direct that my debts and funeral expenses be paid
also the cost of the Tombstone I have directed to be placed over the grave of my Nephew Joseph
Anderson and the legacy of One Thousand Dollars which I have left my Nephew Alfred
Jones Atkins and the residue of the said proceeds of sale and of the collection of debts owing
my money on hand if any I direct to be divided into five equal parts and I give one of the
said parts to my Nephew Henry Miller and my Niece Mildred Corbin Lucinda Pearson
and Sarah Ellen Keimow - One of the said parts I give to the children of my Sister Elizabeth Ann
Pierce - One of the said parts I give to my Sister Lucinda Atkins - One of the said parts I
give to my Sister Sarah Anderson and the remaining part I give to my brother Henry & James
6th I give and devise to my Brother Henry & James my interest in the tract of land in
Georgia which I own jointly with him to have and to hold for his life and at his death or
if he should die before me I direct that my share of the said tract
of land be sold and the proceeds of sale be divided as I have directed that the residue of the

Georgia which I own jointly with him to have and to hold for his life and at his death or
 corner of the said Henry & Jones shall deem it, I direct that my share of the said tract
 of land be sold and the proceeds of sale be divided as I have directed that the residue of the
 proceeds of the sale of my personal property and of the collections of my debts be divided in
 the fifth clause of my will. And I hereby authorize and empower my Brother Henry &
 Jones to sell and convey my share of the said tract of land at any time he may think
 proper - 7th I constitute and appoint my Brother Henry & Jones and my nephew
 William Anderson Executors of this my last will and testament and direct that no
 security be required of them - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands this
 27th day of April 1865
