If either of my sisters or brother should die without children I wish their share to be equally divided amongst my brother and sisters who are living and the heirs of them who may have died the heirs taking by stocks. I do further more will that all the property, monies, valuables which I have made my self to be divided into six (6) equal parts and given and disposed of in the following manner. I will my father Joseph A. Latouradais one of the above named shares and appoint my brother Rennie M. Latouradais to let him have part of it as his necessities may require. I will to my mother Elizabeth Latouradais one share, I will to my brother Rennie

In case of the death of my father or mother I wish their share
equally divided between my sister and brother above named and
of either of them should die I wish that their shares be disposed
of as in the 1st part.

Finally I constitute and appoint my brother Deane M. Latoura-
dais executor of this my last will and testament and do hereby
revoke, annul and vacate all other wills or testamentary writings
