for all men to die do Ordain and make this my last Will & Testament and firstly
all I Give & recommend my Soul to God who gave it me and my body to be buried
in a Christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors and as touching
my worldly Estate with which it has pleased God to bless me with I Give and
bequeath in the manner & form following -

Impressed upon my Will & desire is that my beloved wife have my whole Estate
during her widowhood but in case she marries to have only what the law allows
Then it is my will that my Son Robert Henton have my negro Girl Pat which
I formerly lent him to him & his heirs forever -

Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Henton my Negroe man named
Nat. during her natural life

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Betty Henton my Negroe Girl named Judith
to her and her heirs forever -

my worldly Estate with which it has pleased God to bless me with I give and bequeath in the manner & form following -

First I desire that my will & desire is that my beloved wife have my whole Estate during her widowhood but in case she marries to have only what the law allows. Next it is my will that my Son Robert Henton have my negro Girl Pat which I formerly lent him to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Henton my Negro man named Ned during her natural life.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Betty Henton my Negro Girl named Judith to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Susanna Henton my negro woman Trent to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Henton my Negro named James to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Henton my Negro Girl named Letty to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Kate Henton my negro Girl named Minnie to her

and heirs forever —

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Henton my Negro girl named Dora to her & her heirs forever —

Then I give and bequeath to my son William Henton my Negro Man named Tom to him and his heirs forever —

Then I give and bequeath to my son John Henton my Negro boy named Dick to him and his heirs forever —

Then I give and bequeath to my son George Henton my Negro girl named Mary to him and his heirs forever —

Then I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Henton my Plantation wherein I now live as far as the Road which runs through near the middle of my land to him & his heirs forever but for want of heirs lawful of his body to return as an equal dividend among the surviving part of my children —

Then I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Henton the rest of my land from that dividing road before mentioned to Morathie branch to him and his heirs forever but for want of heirs lawfully begotten of his body to return in like manner as his brother Thomas's before mentioned — It is my Will and desire that all my Just debts be paid & Satisfied —

It is my Will and desire that if any of my before mentioned Children die without lawfull Heirs of their bodies their Estate left them Shall be equally divided among the Surviving Children —

It is my Will & desire that if any of before mentioned Children Should loose their Negroes by any means before divided that they Shall have another if there be any increase from those already mentioned or Fifty pounds out of my Estate —

It is my Will and desire that if my daughter Molly Should continue to be divested of her reason that my Son Thomas Hewton Shall keep her & have the use of her Estate as long as She continues in that Situation or lives & then to be divided among all my Children before mentioned —

It is my Will & desire that Should my Wife die before my youngest Child arrive to the age of Sixteen years that they be Sufficiently educated & maintained out of my Estate untill they come to the age of Sixteen years — It is my Will and desire after the decease of my Wife that my Land in Aberneth County be sold on the most advantageous terms Such as observing a credit for the same untill my youngest Child arrive to the age of Sixteen years or otherwise Should my Executors hereafter mentioned find the most to my Estate or Childrens interest & the produce thereof to be equally divided

among all my Children before mentioned —

It is my Will & desire that should my Wife die before my youngest Child arrive to the age of Sixteen years that they be sufficiently educated & maintained out of my Estate untill they come to the age of Sixteen years — It is my Will and desire after the decease of my Wife that my Land in Aberneth County be sold on the most advantageous terms such as obtaining a credit for the same untill my youngest Child arrive to the age of Sixteen years or otherwise should my Executors hereafter mentioned find the most to my Estate or Childrens interest & the produce thereof to be equally divided among all my surviving Children excepting my Son Thomas & Alexander whom I have already provided for in land.

Item it is my Will and desire that all the remainder of my Estate not before mentioned or given be equally divided among my Children Robert Mary Susannah Betty Sally Nancy Thomas Alexander William Betty John Lucy & George Hentons or their survivors. Item I nominate and appoint my loving Wife my Son Robert my son Thomas my son Alexander and my Friend Thomas Williams to be my Executors of this my last Will and Testament Revoking and disannulling all other former Wills by me before made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my

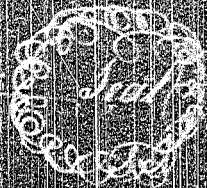

therein named who made oath according to law & giving security a certificate is
granted them for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
