son of Robert Tomlin Deceased a Negro man named Joe and a
Negro Boy named Tob and all residue and Remainder of My
Estate both Real and personal Wheresoever the same now is or
shall be at the time of my Decease after my Debts and Funerals

In presence of his said of them I appoint my Nephew Robert Johnson and
my Friend Williamson Ball my Executors. hereby revoking all former
wills by me made; and Declaring this to be my last will and Testament.
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day
of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and
Sixty one
