and Memory do make & Ordain my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following (viz)

I hereby give & bequeath my Soul into y^e hands of God & give
my Body to y^e Earth to be decently buried as my Executors hereafter
named shall think fitt & touching my worldly Estate wherewith
it hath pleased God to bless me withall I do dispose of after the
following manner.

It is my Will & desire y^t my Debts and Buriall Charges be paid
and Discharged. —

Item I do give and bequeath unto my Loving Son in Law Sam^l Nicolls
all my Estate Real & personal moveable & fixt either in this
County or elsewhere to him & his heirs for Ever who after I do
hereby nominate & appoint whole & sole Executor of this my
last Will & Testament wholly Revoking all former Wills by me
heretofore at any time made & acknowledged for this my last Will &
Testament As Witness my hand & Seal this 2^d Day of May 1717.
