of all my sins, and as for my worldly Estate I dispose of as followeth.
I give and bequeath unto Jane Turner one feather bed and furniture
belonging to it and six pewter Dishes two of them are large dishes
and two pewter Spoons and a dozen more a half of pewter

I give and bequeath unto John Spooner another my Brope that
I made last the Porter is Mr John Roads and my Brope at William
Roads.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Giles Carter another my Brope that of
Clothes and also an other Coat and Sackett.

Item. I give and bequeath unto John Roads my Brope that of Clothes
and six hundred pounds of Tobacco if he stands Indebted to me.

Item. I give and bequeath unto William Carter the son of Giles Carter
one Mare and Mare Colt with all their Increase for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto James Legone Iron Pot and what
Tobacco he dibows me.

Item. I give unto Patrick Formoley the five hundred p. of Tobacco
which he is Indebted to me.

Item. I give unto Jane Carter's Children one Bible one Testam. and
Balter and a spelling book.

Item. I give unto James Carter one Large Coat, Sicking Sackett & to
pair of breeches.
