Submitting through the merits of my blessed Saviour to receive pardon
of all my sins and as for my worldly Estate I dispose of as follows
I give and bequeath unto John Carter one feather bed and furniture
belonging to it and six pewter Dishes two of them are large dishes
and two pewter Spoons and a dozen and a half of pewter

That as and one hundred and fifteen pounds and rather my hope that
I made last the Porter is at John Reed and my hope at William
Reed.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Giles Carter one hundred Cloth Suit of
Clothes and also an outer Coat and Jacket.

Item. I give and bequeath unto John Reed one hundred Cloth Suit of Clothes
and six hundred pounds of Tobacco if he stands Indebted to me.

Item. I give and bequeath unto William Carter the son of Giles Carter
one Mare and Mare Colt with all their Increase for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto James Legone Iron Pot and a half
Tobacco he owes me.

Item. I give unto Patrick Formoley the five hundred p. of Tobacco
which he is Indebted to me.

Item. I give unto Jane Carter's Children one Bible one Testament and
Balter and a spelling book.

Item. I give to James Carter one Large Coat, Ficking Jacket & to
pair of breeches.

And I do hereby make constitute and appoint my friend James
Carter my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament to right on one the other side the paper. In Testimony
