In the Name of God Amen I Daniel Lawson of the Parish of Lumburg in the County of Richmond being in perfect Sense and memory thanks be to Almighty God have & do make this my last Will and Testament here by revoking all other Wills & Testaments heretofore made by me.

Impreses I give & bequeath to my Son Thomas Lawson one hundred Acres of Land in Gloucester County to him this heirs forever also two Negroes by name Sarah and David; Item I give & bequeath to my Son William Lawson one hundred Acres of Land in Gloucester County together with two Negroes namely Hannah & Fanny to him and this heirs forever; Item I give to my Son Richard Lawson one hundred Acres of Land in Gloucester County together with two Negroes by name Dinah & her Son Solomon to him this heirs forever also the feather

Bed & Bedstead together with the furniture thereunto belonging & the increase of the said
Negroe Dinah. Item I give to my Daughter Rebecca Lefson Dobyas a Bond of John
Kows due me from the said Mary, amounting to three thousand pounds of Tobacco which I
propose to deliver immediately to her husband Mr. Thomas Dobyas; Item I give to my
Daughter Bathsheba Allison two Negroes by name John & Winney the feather Bed
she has always lain on when living with me & the furniture thereunto belonging
also one bed & Coll chosen by her or some Person deputed for her; Item I give and
bequeath to my Son Daniel Lawson all my lands in Richmond County to him & his
Heirs forever, also my Negroe man John together with all my Stocks furniture and every
other estate what-soever not before given It is my will & desire that my Estate shall
not be appraised or Inventoried, and lastly I do Nominate & Appoint my Son Daniel
Lawson my Sole Executor of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto Set my hand & Seal this fiftth day of October Anno Domini 1787.
