and Furniture

Item I give to my Niece Nancy Downman one bed and Furniture

I give to my Niece Molly Dobyns one bed and Furniture

Item I give to my Niece Minny Sydnor one bed And furniture

Item I give to my Nephew Giles Sydnor my large Looking Glass

Item I give to my Sister Ann Mitchell my Large Bible during her Life

And then to bequeath to my Nephew James Sydnor

Item I give to my Nephew James Sydnor my Desk

Item I give to my Nephews John Sydnor and Giles Sydnor all my Tobacco

And that is in the House and which is due me to be Equally divided between them

Item I give to my Sister Ann Mitchell And my Nephew Giles Sydnor All the

Part of the House and Kitchen Furniture to be Equally divided between them

them also it is my will and desire that all my Cattle Hogs and Sheep should be

divided between my Sister Ann Mitchell and my Nephew Giles Sydnor
Item It is my desire that all my crop of corn and Tobacco should be Equally
Divided between my Sister Ann Mitchell my Niece Deanna Smither and
my Nephew Giles Sydnor

Item I give to my Nephew Jagers Downman my Brandy Still and it is my Will
and desire that all my Negroes should go as my Father's Will directs And lastly
I constitute and Appoint my Nephew John Sydnor and my Nephew Giles
Sydnor Executors of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have
here to set my hand and seal this 22nd day of October 1789

A Court held for Richmond County the twentieth day of December 1789

This last will and Testament of Dewanna Sydnor dec^d was presented in Court by John Sydnor and Giles Sydnor the sons therein named who made oath that according to law & being proved by the oaths of two of the witnesses thereto was admitted to Record. Dewanna Smith one of the witnesses who proved the same having given up his legacy in the said will

In the Name of God Amen the twenty third day of November Anno domⁱ one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight I William Galt of the County of Richmond being weak in body but of Sound Memory well knowing the uncertainty of this mortal state do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it and my Body I leave to the earth to be decently Interred at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and as to what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and dispose of in the manner following
