I give unto my Son Edward Barrow all my Lands and Plantation whereon I now live to him & his heirs for ev^r. Only reserving to my Loving Wife Ann the use of the said Lands & Plantation During her Natural Life

Item I hereby Impower my Ex^r. hereafter Men^d to Sell all that Exact or Offset of Lands at y^e Mines to raise Money for to pay what Money I owe

Item I give unto my well beloved Daughter Anne Barrow Three hundred Ac^r of Land lying at the Deep run Commonly Called the Forest at y^e Marsh in King George County to her and her heirs for ev^r. to the same more or less

Item I give unto my s^r. Son Edw^d. Two Neg^r Viz^t. Jack and George and One Mulattoe Boy Named Will

Item I give unto my Daughter Anne One Neg^r. named Will to her and her heirs for ev^r. and One Mulattoe Girl named Sarah

Item I give unto my Daughter Margaret One Neg^r. Woman named Hannah to her & her heirs for ev^r. Also I give to my s^r. Daughter Margaret One Mulattoe Boy named Sam^l. all the rest of my Neg^r. that are not already disposed of I give unto my Loving Wife Anne During her Natural Life and after her Decease my Will and desire is that them & there Successors be Equally divided between my s^r. Son Edw^d. my Daughter Anne and Margaret

Item I give all my Estate in England to my s^r. Son Edward and his heirs for ev^r. and also my Gray horse Called Robin

Item I give to my Daughter Anne a Coffer of sum q^d forty eight Gall^{ts}. that stands in the

Anne during her Nat^l Life and after her decease my Will and desire is that
them & there Heirs to be Equally divided between my s^r Son Edw^d my Daughter
Anne and Margaret - Brought to.

Item I give all my Estate in England to my s^r Son Edward and his Heirs for ev^r and also
my Gray Horse called Robin -
