Plantation Innow Live on and all my Personal Estate during
her natural Life and at her Death I give the before mentioned
Plantation to my Daughter Elizabeth Jones and her heirs
to have and to enjoy God merciful Daughter Elizabeth Jones

for ever and if please God my said Daughter Elizabeth Jones
shoul Depart this Life before she attains to the age of twenty
one years or marriage day which may happen first then my will
and Desire is that the before mentioned Land maybe Equally
Divided amongst my other Daughters Winnefred Jones, Lucy Jones
and Margaret Jones or sold and the money Equally divided between
them which may suit them the best and all the Remaining part of
my Estate I leave to be Equally Divided between my four Daughters
Winnefred Jones, Elizabeth Jones, Lucy Jones, and Margaret Jones
at my wife Barbary Jones's Death and wearing Cothes I leave to
the use of my Family not to be appraised nor Inventories and I ap-
point my brother Isaac Jones my Executor and I do revoke and make

my estate I leave to be equally divided between my four Daughters
Winnefred Jones, Elizabeth Jones, Lucy Jones, and Margaret Jones
at my wife Barbary Jones's Death and wearing Cloaths I leave to
the use of my Family not to be appraised nor Inventoried and I ap-
point my brother Isaac Jones my Executor and I do revoke and make
Void all other wills by me Written or spoken and acknowledge this
to be my last will and Testament in witness I do hereunto set
my hand and seal the day and year first above written.....
