loweth I give and bequeath to my daughter Ellen Hutton one negro Boy named John, my

be equal divided between my daughter Elizabeth Brown, and my daughter Margret Brown,
and all the Rest of my Estate, and lastly I do appoint Alexander Hutton and Richard Blay-
ton to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament and Witness my hand & Seal this day
year first above written
