Elizabeth Green to be my full and sole Ex^{or}. Item I give to my Son John
Green and to my Son Thomas Green and to my Son George Green and to my
Son Leger Green and to my Son William Green and to my Son Samuel
Green and to my Son Danforth Green and to my Daughter Elizabeth Green
and to my Daughter Grace Green and to my Son Isaac Green I give and
them all my Lands that I do hold and p^{ro}p^{er}ties to them and their heirs
safely begeten of their bodies and to have the Equaley divided amongst
them all and every one of them to take their Part and to have all my movable
Equaley divided amongst my son mentioned Children and my Wife apart
Item I give to my Son Robert Green one Shilling Sterling money and this I
do Ordaine as my Last Will and Testament Reversing all other Will
Things I set to my hand this Ninth day of June 1716
