Item it is my will and Desire that if my Loving Wife Francis Webb
Should Marry that then She shall have no part or parcel of my Estate
Neither Real nor Personal. Item I Give and bequeath my home plantation
To my son John Webb Bounded by the Road ^{that} Leads from the Beaverdam
To the Little Mill after my wife Decease or at the End of fourteen
Years after the Date of my Will I Give to him & his heirs for ever Lawfully
To be Begotten of his Body and for want of such I Give to my son Isaac
Webb to him and his heirs for ever. Item I Give all the rest of my Lands
To my son Gualbert Webb to him and the heirs of his Body Lawfully
Begotten after the Death of my wife Francis Webb or at the End
Of fourteen years after the Date of my will. And Lastly I Do Appoint
My Loving wife Francis Webb and my friend Joshua Singleton
To be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will &
