11. I Give to my Grand Daughter Lorna Lyall a Feather bed & a heavy bolster

a Heifer & a large pewter dish and half a dozen pewter plates.

13. I Give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Lyall one large chest with drawers
and all my remaining Linnen?

14. I Give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Lawson one bow and Galf.

15. I Give to my Grand Daughter Ann Branchon my large Turck
my velvet hood and my silver chalice?

16. I Give all my remaining Cloths Excepting the Linnen which I have
already Given away to be Equally Divided between my Daughter
Sarah Lawson and my Grand Daughter Ann Branchon.

17. It is my Will and desire that all the rest of my Estate be Equally
