it is my Will & desire to dispose of the same in the following mannerly
Item. I give and bequeath to my loving Brother Spencer Brannon my
Plantation, to him & his heirs forever
Item. It is my Will & desire that my Sister Barbary be allowed a home
on my Plantation during her continuing a Single life
Item. I give & bequeath to my Brother aforesaid my House & Saddle
with a draft, I can also my wearing apparel except a pair of Silver
Shoe Buckles which I give to my Sister Barbary
Item. I give to my Sister Barbary all my Estate not before mentioned to
him & his heirs forever I do hereby nominate & appoint
my Brother Spencer Brannon & my Friend Thomas Williams as
Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal this third day of December 1790

It is my Will & desire to dispose of the same in the following manner.
Item. I give and bequeath to my loving Brother Spencer Branan my
Plantation, to him & his heirs forever.

Item. It is my Will & desire that my Sister Barbary be allowed a home
on my Plantation during her continuing a single life.

Item. I give & bequeath to my Brother aforesaid my Horse & Saddle
with a draft Steer Also my wearing apparel except a pair of blue
Shoe Buckles which I give to my Sister Barbary.

Item. I give to my Sister Barbary all my Estate not before mentioned to
her & her heirs forever. I do hereby nominate & appoint
my Brother Spencer Branan & my Friend Thomas Williams as
Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal this third day of December 1790.
