following, that is to say, Principally First of all I commend my Soul into the
hands of almighty God who gave it me, and my Body I commit to the Earth, to be
buried in a Christian, like and decent manner, at the discretion of my Executor, hereafter
named, and as touching such Worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me
with in this life, I give devise and dispose thereof in manner following
In the first place my Will and desire is that all my Just Debts be paid
Then Secondly my Will and desire is that the whole & Sole of my Estate both Real and
personal shall be equally divided between my two Sons, to wit, Marks Crask and Joel
Crask which I give to my aforementioned Sons and their Lawfully begotten heirs forever.
Thirdly and Lastly I constitute appoint and Ordain my trusty and well beloved friends
