Item The rest of my Estate Goods & Chattels Real or personal I Give & bequeath
to be equally divided between my three Children that is John, Elizabeth and
Mary Hinds. I Do hereby appoint, Nominate and constitute Joseph Woodard
Exec^r of this my last Will & Testament, That is for to take care of my
Childrens Plantation And for his trouble I desire that he may have an
equal part of every thing that he makes with the hands that is to labour

that now or ever did pass to him and his heirs forever —

Item The rest of my Estate Goods & Chattels Real or personal I give & bequeath to be equally divided between my three children that is John, Elizabeth and Mary Hinds — I do hereby appoint, Nominate and Constitute Joseph Woodard Exec^r of this my last will & Testament, That is for to take care of my children & Plantation And for his trouble I desire that he may have an Equal part of every thing that he makes with the hands that is to labour on my said Plantation — And I do hereby Ratify & Confirm that no other to be my last will & Testament. Signed Sealed published & Declared as such this 12th day of February 1755.
