 and County of Kent being sick and weak of Memory bless'd be God do make and Ordain this my Last
 Will and Testament in manner and form following after all my Just
 Debts and Funerals are paid and Discharged

I Give unto my Brother Henry Jones Son of John Jones and Mary
 that Tract of Land I now live on between the Line of Mr. Griffin and
 a branch known by the Name of Christopher's branch to him and his
 heirs for Ever

I Give unto William Cooper Son of Thomas Cooper Son of
 a Tract of Land beginning at a Little branch that makes out of the
 branch known by the Name of Christopher's branch and running up
 the small Branch as there to Redwell Line and along the Line

I John Ham down to Christopher's Branch and down the Branch to a place where it begins, which I have I give to him and his heirs for ever.

I do appoint my Father in Law John Ham my Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Charles one fat-headed mare colt, 2119 and two blankits and one horse brood and saddle and a large pot one pultr dish and three Plates, Six Spuns, a large handkerchief, a skin pan and a set of trowsers.
