Impressed. I bequeath my soul to God who grant and my body to be buried by my Executors  
hereafter named.

Item. I give and bequeath to my dear Wife Rebecca Thomson all the Debt that is  
out due to me in Henry Bennetts hand eight hundred and thirty five of Debt  
and five hundred in Richard Jones hand and five hundred more in Francis  
Jones hand that lives upon my Plantation full Year and a half the said Debt  
and five hundred pounds of Debt upon the Account of my Yearly Rent.

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Thomson a Bed and furniture  
belonging to them a Fort Bed and a small bed of Quilt and a Pillow and a  
new foot and foot board.

Item. I give and bequeath to my Wife the other 2 Beds and furniture belonging to  
them the great foot and 2 other and a new set of Bed and a Couple  
of Bedsteads and all the rest of the said Bed and Furniture and  
about my Wife to be my Executors Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
