sick and weak of Body but of perfect Sense of Mind & Memory thanks be
to God now do hereby knowing y^e certainty of Mortality think fit at this time
to make Constitute & Appoint this my Last Will & Testament in manner
& form following (viz:) —

I Commit my Soul to God my Lord & Saviour & my Body to be interred in the Earth

And then I desire that all my Lots that I am weary in Law & Controversie
 on & be fully satisfied by my Execution herin to be mentioned after I
 order my Executor which I have considered thus My Son Joseph I have
 some what I am able for him & also for my Daughter Phoebe for my Son
